Snow emergency declared in Borough of Middletown

Middletown Mayor James H. Curry III has declared a snow emergency in the Borough. The snow emergency will be in effect at least for the remainder of today, January 21, 2014, but can be extended if necessary.

Borough offices are also closed today, due to the snow emergency.

During a declared snow emergency, parking restrictions go into effect to facilitate the removal of snow from Borough streets. During such an emergency, it is unlawful to park on the north side of designated east-west streets or on the east side of designated north-south streets, unless otherwise indicated.

Once the snow has been removed from those parking areas, parking there becomes permissible as long there is no interference with the Borough snow removal crews and no interference with traffic during the remainder of the emergency.
