DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on or about September 1, 2021 Hurricane Ida has caused or threatens to cause injury, damage, and suffering to the persons and property of the Borough of Middletown; and

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2021, in anticipation of the storm, Governor Wolf declared a State of Emergency for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the disaster has endangered the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in the Borough of Middletown, and threatens to create problems greater in scope than the Borough of Middletown, may be able to resolve; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents of the Borough of Middletown.

NOW, THEREFORE, I the undersigned Mayor of the Borough of Middletown pursuant to the provisions of Section 7101-7707 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA CS), as amended, do hereby declare the existence of a disaster emergency in the Borough of Middletown,

FURTHER, I direct the Borough of Middletown Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this emergency

STILL FURTHER, I authorize officials of the Borough of Middletown to act as necessary to meet the current exigencies of this emergency, namely; by the employment of temporary workers, by the rental of equipment, by the purchase of supplies and materials, and by entering into such contracts and agreements for the performance of public work as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, mandatory constitutional requirements excepted.

This Declaration shall take effect immediately, and shall remain in effect until the conditions warrant relinquishment of the same.
