

Council Meeting Highlights (11/1/22)

- Council agreed to purchase the property at 231 Oak Hill Drive for the purpose of expansion to the Spruce Street Substation.
- Council adopted Ordinance 2022-1397 repealing Section 60-2 and Ordinance 1296 in their entirety.
- Council adopted Resolution 2022-24 approving the comprehensive Lexipol Police Department Policy Manual in its entirety except for the policy relating to Internal Affairs and portable audio/video recorders.
- Advertising was approved for Ordinance 2022-1400 establishing that customers who have had their electric service disconnected must schedule reconnection of service.
- Resolution 2022-25 authorizing the Tax Collector to accept and approve waiver requests in accordance with Act 57 of 2022 was adopted.
- Council approved fund transfers as approved by the 2022 budget.
- Council appointed Brown, Schultz, Sheridan & Fritz as auditor for the year ending December 31, 2022.
- Council accepted the Woodland Hills Development and Stormwater Management Agreements for Phases 6B, 8, 9, and 10B.
- Council approved the Special Event request from the Historical Society to hold the 2nd Annual Frosty 5K Run/Walk on December 3, 2022 from 7:00 a.m. until approximately 11:00 a.m.
- Council authorized the annual contribution of \$2,400 to Neighborhood Dispute Settlements.
- Council approved the final payment to JVI Group, Inc. for the N Union & Emaus Street Paving Project.
