

**MIDDLETOWN BOROUGH
PUBLIC NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given that on July 5, 2023 at 7:00 P.M. the Council of the Borough of Middletown, Dauphin County, PA will hold a public meeting at the Middletown Borough Hall, Council's Chambers, 60 West Emaus St., Middletown, PA 17057, at which meeting the Council will consider the enactment of a revised proposed ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the Borough. The title and summary of the proposed ordinance amendment are as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-1406**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPENDIX OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLETOWN, CHAPTER A265
CIVIL SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS, TO PROVIDE
BOROUGH COUNCIL THE DISCRETION TO WAIVE ACT 120
CERTIFICATION FOR POLICE OFFICER CANDIDATES.**

Section 1 amends the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Middletown, Appendix, Chapter A265, Section A265-4, Applications, at (A)(4) and (D) to clarify that the requirements for entry level testing will be established by and testing will be performed by the Civil Service Commission (the "Commission") or its designee. Section A265-4(B) regarding general qualifications is amended to provide that Borough Council may waive the Act 120 requirement based on the needs of the Borough's Police Department per the Chief of Police/Public Safety Director. Section A265-7(A)(1) and (E) addressing entry-level examinations and the administration of those examinations respectively, are both rewritten to authorize the Commission or its designee to conduct said written or agility entry-level tests and oral examinations.

Section 2 is a severability section providing that if any provision of the proposed Ordinance is invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3 repeals all prior ordinances or parts thereof that are inconsistent with the proposed Ordinance.

Section 4 provides that the proposed Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with applicable law.
