ORDINANCE NO. 2025-1425

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLETOWN, DAUPHIN COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 252 OF THE BOROUGH CODE DEALING WITH  
VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

A summary of the proposed amendment to the Code of Ordinances is as follows:

Section 1 will amend Section 252-15 of Chapter 252 by adding certain stop sign locations to the table of stop sign intersections. Section 2 is a severability section providing that if any provision of the proposed Ordinance is invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect. Section 3 repeals all prior ordinances or parts thereof that are inconsistent with the proposed Ordinance. Section 4 provides that the proposed Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with applicable law.
