PROCLAMATION BY MAYOR OF MIDDLETOWN

WHEREAS, conditions in Middletown Borough will most likely deteriorate as a result of the forecasted heavy snowfall and accumulation, it is necessary to prohibit certain conduct in order to preserve the public peace.

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me by Section 252 of the Middletown Borough Code, I hereby declare a snow emergency within Middletown Borough and proclaim as follows:

- 1) For the duration of this snow emergency, in order to safeguard general welfare, permit free travel of emergency vehicles, and allow for snow removal operations without unnecessary hindrance, all persons are hereby directed not to operate motor vehicles in Middletown Borough, **except for essential travel or to preserve health and safety.**
- 2) For the duration of this snow emergency, motor vehicles parked on the sides of streets marked "Snow Emergency Route" will be subject to immediate tow away.
- 3) For the duration of this snow emergency, all persons are hereby directed to obey all orders of Middletown Borough police officers, state police officers, and all other duly constituted peace officers regarding routes for pedestrian and vehicular traffic.
- 4) This snow emergency and Proclamation shall remain in effect until further notice.
